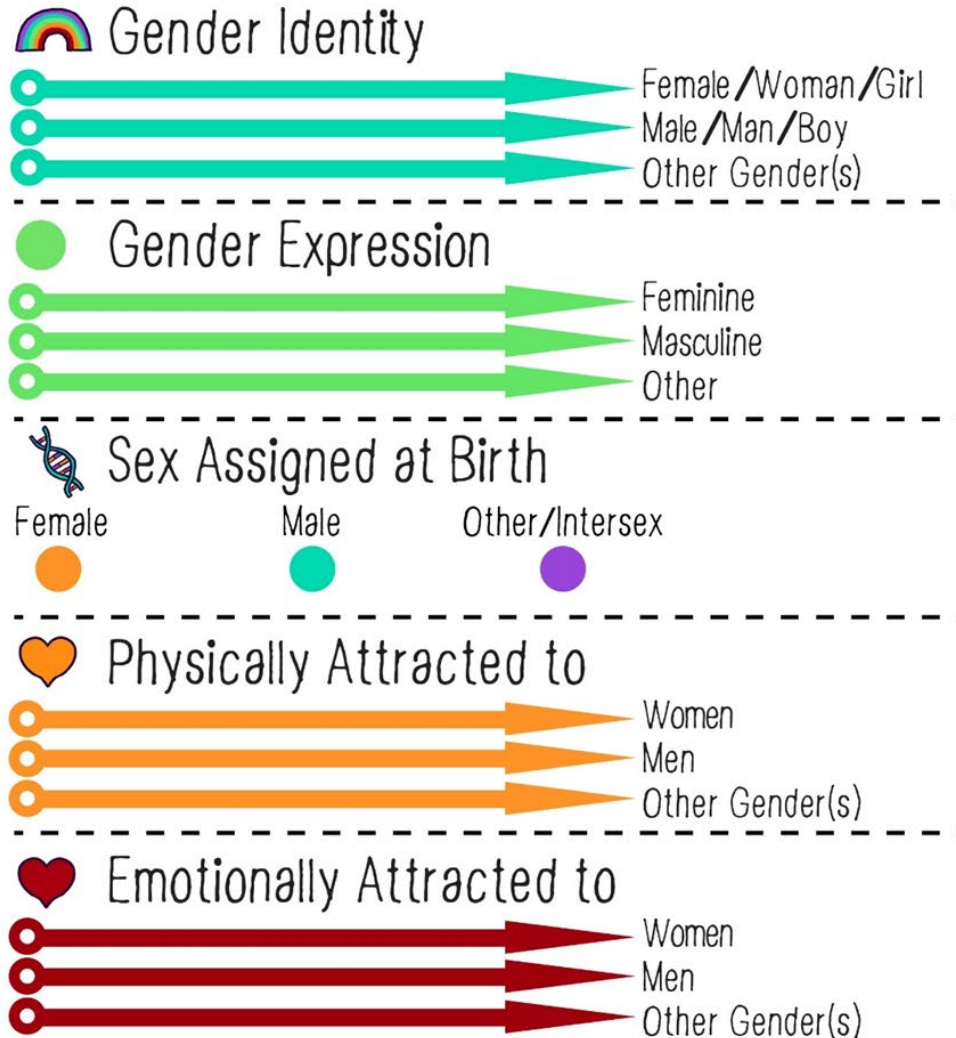
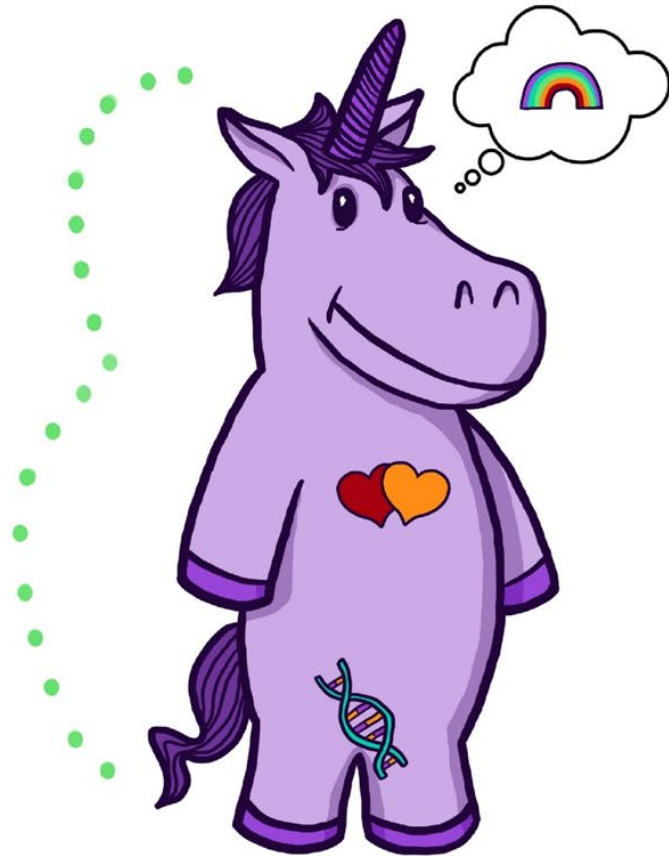

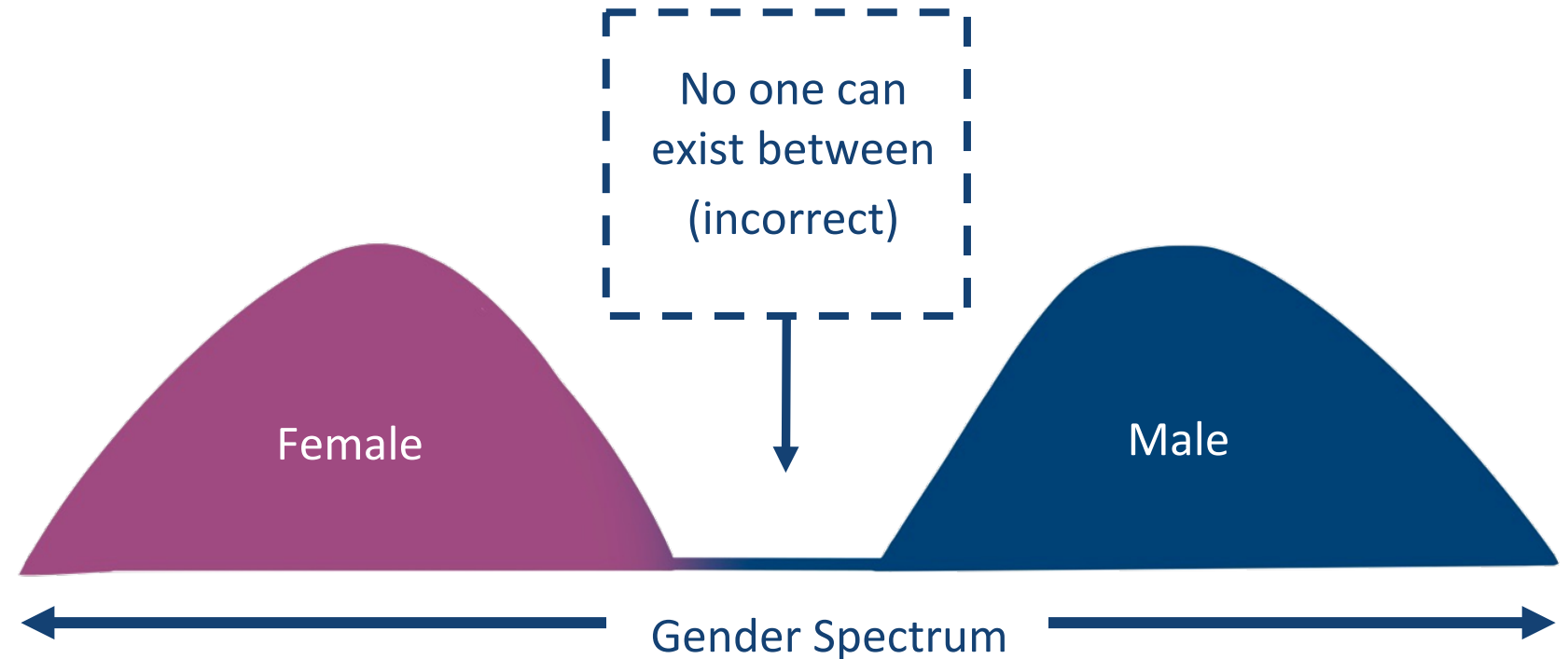

It's not binary



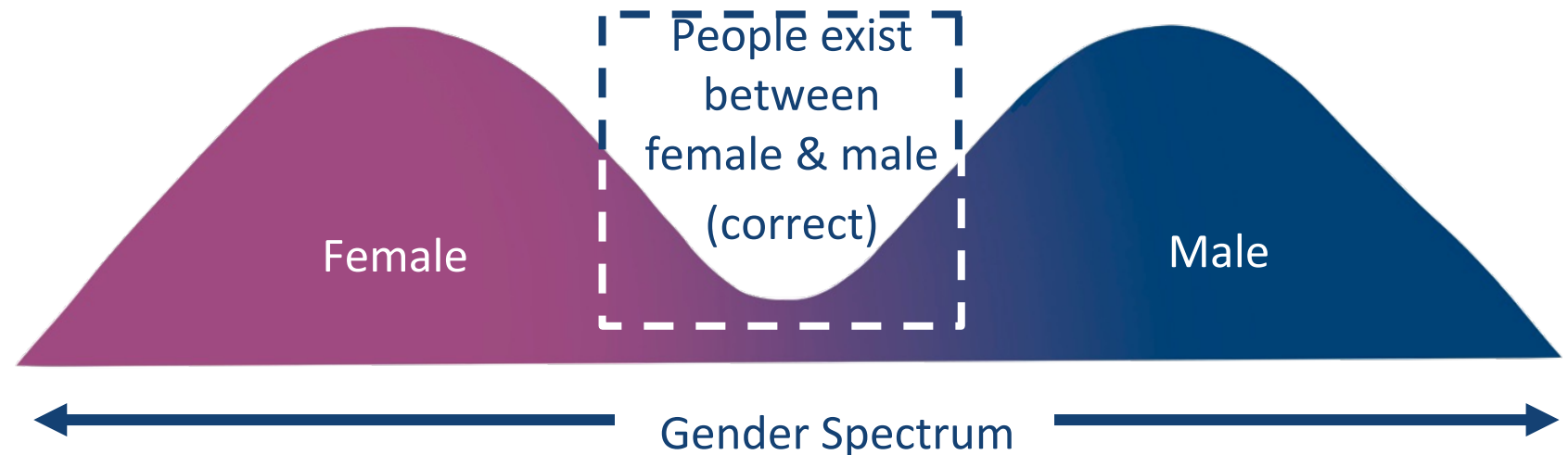
Understanding Biological Sex

Typical markers of biological sex:

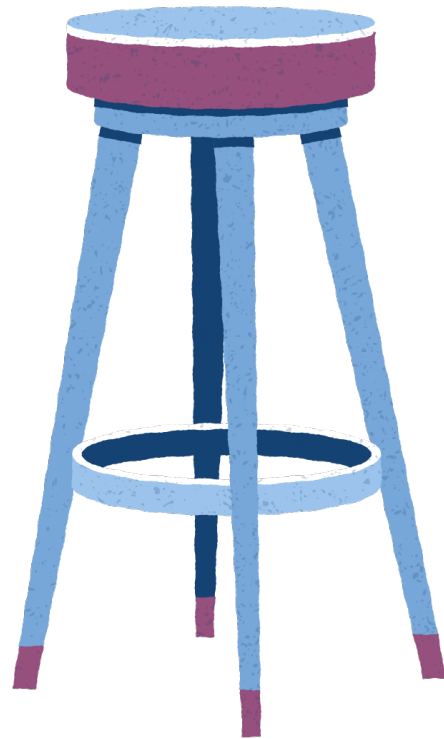
- Bone structure

Cisgender

Someone whose gender identity corresponds with the sex they were assigned at birth.

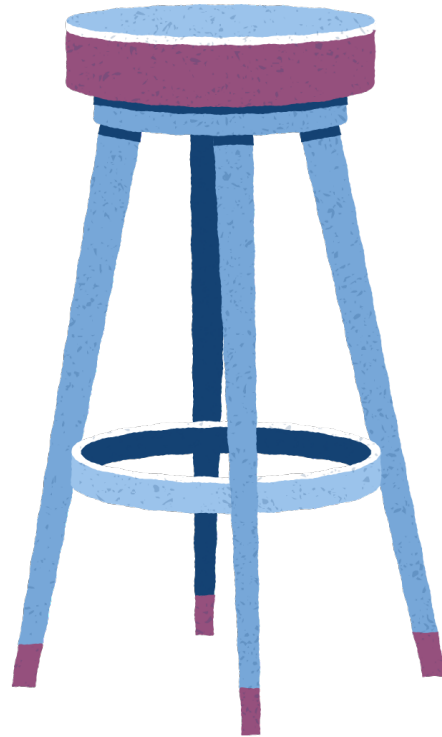


Where are you sitting?



Transgender

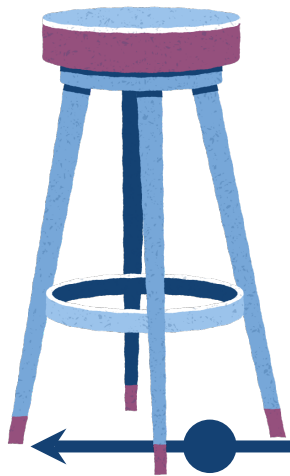
Someone whose gender identity is *different* than the sex they were assigned at birth.

Nonbinary

Relating to or being a person who identifies with or expresses a gender identity that is neither entirely male nor entirely female.
